Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Pennsylvania School Code, Section 1402, stipulates that **medical examinations** shall be provided for all children. These are given upon original entry (Kindergarten or first grade), in sixth grade, and in eleventh grade. Transfer students and students with incomplete health records may also be required to have a physical examination. The only exemption to this school health law is for religious beliefs.

We are recommending that these examinations be done by your family physician since he/she can best evaluate and assist in obtaining the necessary treatment. The family physician should complete the attached form. The completed form must be returned to the school nurse by the beginning of the school year.

If you are unable to have the examination done by your family physician, please complete and return the slip at the bottom of this letter **by the beginning of the school year**.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us to carry out this phase of the school health program.
