1. Meet Dr. Stuart Savin, Administrative Director of Lancaster County CTC

Dr. Stuart Savin introduced himself as the new Administrative Director of Lancaster County CTC. Warwick currently has eighty-one students being served at the CTC. Dr. Savin is pleased to partner with the school districts, to plan, and move forward to provide training to students. He spoke about the need for trained personnel in the area of health care and trades, and how the CTC can look to the future in meeting these needs. Discussion took place regarding educating students and parents about what Lancaster County CTC has to offer, degree programs, career opportunities and training for both students and adults.

Dr. Hallett shared the Future Ready PA Index its components and how progress is indicated through a color and symbol system. Data for each building was presented.
