

Free or Low Cost Immunization Sites

The following places provide free or low cost immunizations. Immunizations are for children ages birth to 18 years of age. A parent or adult guardian must accompany the child. Parents/Guardians must bring past immunization records along.

Lancaster State Health Center 1661 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster offers immunizations for children with Medical Assistance or no insurance **by appointment only** by calling 299-7597.

Lancaster General Hospital's ChildProtect Program offers immunizations free of charge to children with Medical Assistance or no insurance. Information regarding the ChildProtect Program schedule can be obtained by calling 544-3811. Sites are open for walk-ins from 9AM to 7PM.

South East Lancaster Health Services offers free immunizations at several locations for children with no insurance. For more information, call 299-6371.

Welsh Mountain Medical Center offers immunizations at the four locations listed below. For questions, call the Welsh Mountain Medical Center at 354-4711.

- 1) **Ephrata Church of the Brethren:** 201 Crescent Avenue, Ephrata. Immunizations are provided on the 4th Tuesday of the month (except in November and December) and are free for children with no insurance or insurance that doesn't cover any immunization costs.
- 2) **Welsh Mountain Medical and Dental Center:** 584 Springville Road, New Holland. Immunizations are provided on the 4th Thursday of each month (except in November and December). The cost is \$3.00 per child for children with no insurance or insurance that doesn't cover immunization costs.
- 3) **Meadow Creek Family Practice:** 435 South Kinzer Ave, Suite 6, New Holland. (Phone 351-2400) Immunizations are provided on the 2nd Thursday of each month. The cost is \$3.00 per child for children with no insurance or insurance that doesn't cover immunization costs.
- 4) **St. Paul's United Methodist Church:** 105 West Main Street, Terre Hill. Immunizations are provided on the 1st Thursday of the month and are free for children with no insurance or insurance that doesn't cover immunization costs.
